提案單位：管理學院暨各系

案由：有關本院與英國 University of Dundee 商學院簽訂雙聯碩士學位協議書乙案，提請討論。

說明：

- 一、本院將與英國 University of Dundee 商學院簽訂雙聯碩士學位協議書，該校於英國排名 32，世界大學 QS 排名 (2024) 為 441 (台大 69、北科大 431、中山 505)。
- 二、目前合作以推動雙聯碩士學位為主，本學院之碩士生均可申請。
- 三、各系參加雙聯碩士學位協議，對於原先課程安排不會有任何影響，老師們毋需額外將課程轉為全英文授課，英國 University of Dundee 商學院也接受以我方課程折抵對方課程。
- 四、學生可以選擇到 Dundee 修習半年或一年，一年折抵約 25% 的學費並有企業實習機會，半年則是折抵 50% 學費。
- 五、台灣與英國的學分計算不同，本院一門課多為 3 學分，對方則為 10-20 學分，因此原則上會以「課程抵課程」方式處理。

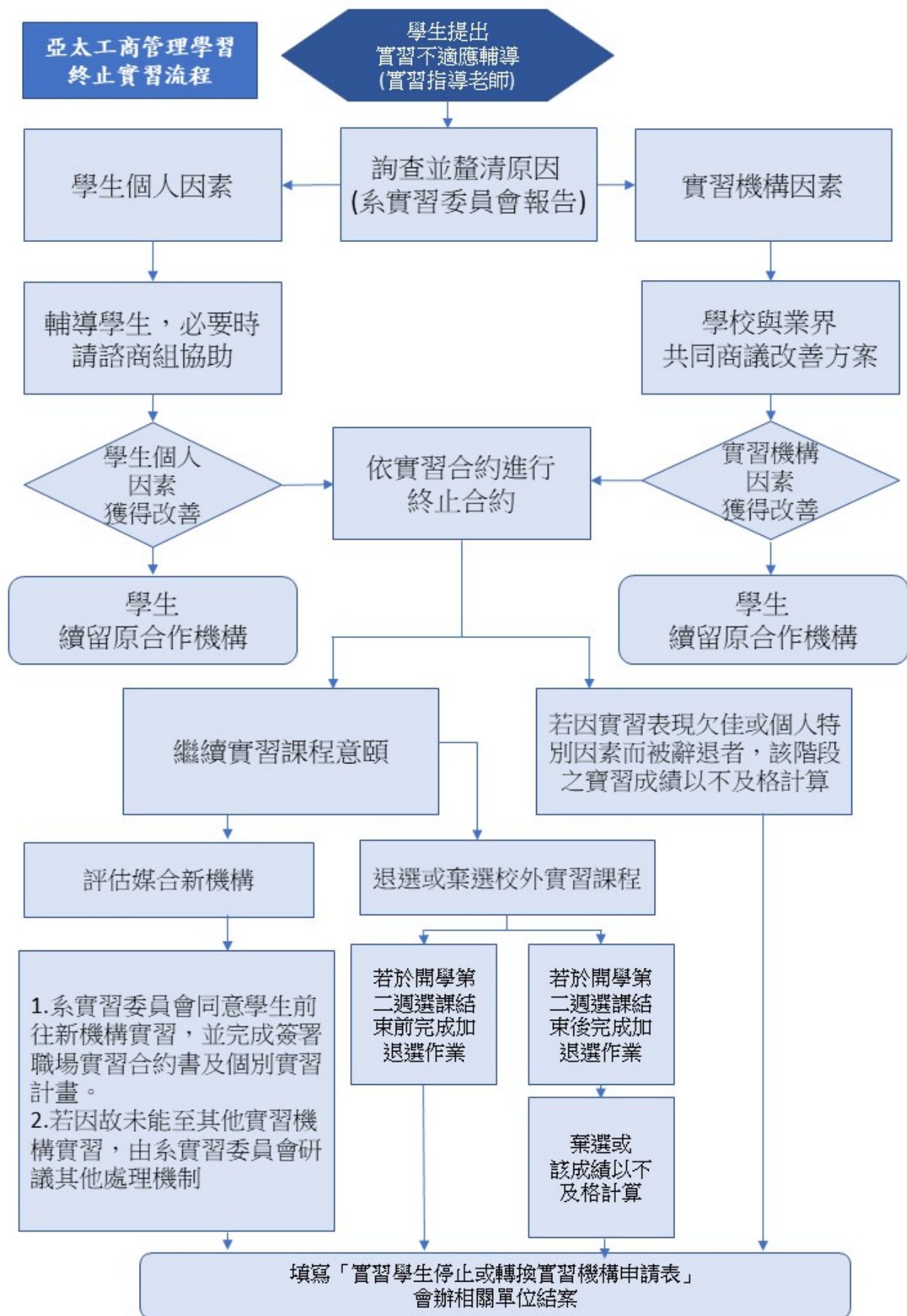

ARTICULATION CONDITIONS

1 Nature of the Agreement

- 1.1 This agreement provides for articulation between the NUK Programme(s) and the UoD Programme(s) as outlined in the Articulation Details. The parties agree to collaborate in good faith, openly and honestly to design and deliver the articulation arrangement.
- 1.2 Other than where expressly stated, this agreement is not deemed to signify any other accreditation or approval by UoD of NUK's Standards, Quality, or services.

2 Form of Articulation and Award

- 2.1 The parties agree that students shall :
 - (a) undertake the number of academic years on the NUK Programme, as stated in the Articulation Details; and
 - (b) if admitted to the UoD Programme, undertake the number of academic years on the UoD Programme at the UoD, as stated in the Articulation Details.
- 2.2 Each student who successfully completes and passes the UoD Programme will receive :
 - (a) a degree certificate from UoD; and
 - (b) a transcript from UoD.
- 2.3 NUK may provide students with its own transcript. Any transcript granted by either the UoD or NUK will state that the credit awarded by that party for the degree or award from the relevant party is also being recognised by the other party as contributing to the specific degree or award of that other party, with the intention that there is no double counting of credits.
- 2.4 UoD shall have sole control of any award or degree or award issued by it.

3 UoD Student Admission Process and Requirements

- 3.1 The admission of any student to the UoD Programme is at the sole discretion of UoD. Any decision on student admission is final and binding. No student is guaranteed entry to the UoD Programme.
- 3.2 Without prejudice to NUK's obligations under clause 5.1 (General Responsibilities of the Parties) prior to commencing the UoD Programme each student must have :
 - (a) attained the English language qualifications set out in the Articulation Details, provided that such requirements shall not be less than UoD's minimum English language qualifications requirements in force from time to time;
 - (b) attained the Specific Credit from NUK in respect of the NUK Programme, as set out in the Articulation Details;

- (c) attained UoD's standard requirements for admission to the UoD Programme from time to time;
 - (d) all relevant UK visa and immigration clearances in order to be able to undertake the UoD Programme;
 - (e) attained any additional admissions requirements as stated in the Articulation Details; and
 - (f) paid all tuition fees and other financial payments in respect of the UoD Programme.
- 3.3 Any student of NUK applying to be admitted to the UoD Programme shall be considered on an individual basis in accordance with UoD's admissions processes from time to time.
- 3.4 Any applicant or student who has not attained UoD's English language requirements before the commencement of the UoD Programme may attend UoD's pre-sessional English Language Programme and attain UoD's English language requirements. UoD will determine admission requirements in respect of this programme and separate fees shall be payable by the student.
- 3.5 The maximum number of students that may be admitted to the UoD Programme in any single intake is set out in the Articulation Details.
- 3.6 Once students are admitted to the UoD, they are subject to UoD's policies, procedures and regulations (including UoD's assessment policies and rules regarding resit opportunities) as updated from time to time.

4 NUK obligations

- 4.1 NUK warrants that :
- (a) The NUK Programme shall be delivered entirely by NUK onsite at NUK's campus as outlined in the Articulation Details;
 - (b) NUK's Programme shall be maintained at a high standard and (as a minimum) to the level existing or expected by UoD;
 - (c) it has the capacity to operate the NUK Programme according to this agreement; and
 - (d) no element of the NUK Programme shall :
 - (i) be delivered by another institution other than NUK;
 - (ii) be delivered by distance learning;
 - (iii) involve articulation or collaboration between NUK and any other institution or person; or
 - (iv) involve Recognition of Prior Learning.
- 4.2 Without prejudice to UoD's other remedies, any element of the NUK Programme which does not comply with the warranties in clause 4.1 will not count towards a UoD degree or form part of the articulation arrangements between the parties.
- 4.3 NUK will :

- (a) provide its students and prospective students information on the UoD Programme, opportunities and support available for students at the UoD, as UoD may reasonably require. All such information and documentation has to be approved by UoD in advance;
- (b) use all reasonable endeavours to encourage students to apply to the UoD Programme. UoD may support NUK in this activity;
- (c) maintain complete records relating to the performance of each student on the NUK Programme (including details of credits obtained) and make such materials available to the UoD on request;
- (d) provide UoD any reasonable assistance in relation to this agreement which UoD may request, including in relation to any audit or inspection.

5 General Responsibilities of the Parties

5.1 Each party will :

- (a) comply with good academic practices and relevant industry practice (including non-discrimination);
- (b) be responsible for the Standards and Quality of its academic programme and for all services and facilities to its students;
- (c) give the other party prior written notice of anything which will affect (or is likely to affect) the delivery, Standards, Quality, learning resources or student intake of that party's programme or these articulation arrangements;
- (d) comply with all applicable laws and regulations;
- (e) follow all applicable codes of practice relating to Quality assurance and accreditation;
- (f) obtain and maintain all necessary consents, licences, permissions and infrastructure to be able to perform its obligations under this agreement;
- (g) act in accordance with its powers and constitution;
- (h) maintain proper records in respect of its responsibilities and obligations under this agreement; and
- (i) provide the other party with such information as may be reasonably requested to facilitate the effective operation and development of the articulation arrangements between the parties (including information required to prepare transcripts).

6 Communication and Co-ordination

6.1 Each party will designate a Link Co-ordinator who will :

- (a) be the main point of contact in relation to these articulation arrangements;
- (b) deal with and manage all matters associated with the articulation arrangements; and

- (c) provide prompt responses to communications received from the other party's Link Co-ordinator.
- 6.2 Either party may change its Link Co-ordinator. Any such change should be communicated to the other party's Link Co-ordinator in advance of such change taking effect.

7 Financial Arrangements

- 7.1 Details of the tuition fees payable by students to the UoD in respect of the UoD Programme and any other financial arrangements are set out in the Articulation Details. The tuition fees for the UoD Programme shall be set by UoD annually in its sole discretion.
- 7.2 In the event that any student fails any year of the UoD Programme and it is permissible for such year to be repeated, the student shall be liable to pay tuition fees at the relevant rate in respect of the repeated year.
- 7.3 Neither party may incur, commit or authorise financial expenditure on behalf of the other.
- 7.4 Each party will be responsible for its own costs and expenses incurred in connection with the delivery of its programme and the negotiation and performance of this agreement.
- 7.5 Students shall be responsible for their own costs and expenses, including accommodation, course materials and equipment, travel, insurance, medical expenses, passports and immigration clearances.

8 Intellectual Property and Marketing Materials

- 8.1 Except to the extent expressly provided for in this agreement, neither party shall have any rights in or to the other party's intellectual property (including pre-existing intellectual property rights, any rights arising as a result of this agreement, rights to names or branding). Each party agrees not to seek to register, dispute or contest the right and title of the other to the other party's intellectual property rights.
- 8.2 Each party grants the other party a non-exclusive royalty free licence for the duration of this agreement to use the other party's name, trade marks, brands and details of the relevant academic programme on approved promotional materials in connection with the articulation arrangement. The licence shall come to an end on the expiry or termination of this agreement.
- 8.3 Any materials or information that are made available by one party to the other will be provided on a royalty-free and "as is" basis, to be used by the receiving institution to enable it to fulfil its obligations under this agreement and without the right to transfer or sub-license to third parties.
- 8.4 Subject to clause 8.5, all publicity and marketing materials to be used by a party which refer to the articulation arrangements, the other party or contain any of the brands of the other party shall be submitted to the other party for prior written approval (which may be given by email). If the proposed material is not written in English, an authorised translation shall be provided.

- 8.5 Each party shall ensure that all marketing materials are accurate and do not contain, derogatory or misleading statements, inaccuracies or anything which could bring another party into disrepute. The parties may mention these articulation arrangements provided they clearly describe the nature and extent of the collaboration and do not make misleading comments regarding Standards, Quality, financial arrangements or services.
- 8.6 Each party shall immediately cease to use the other party's name, materials, logos, trade marks, brochures and other intellectual property rights upon termination or expiry of this agreement.
- 8.7 Each party agrees to uphold the reputation and good name of the academic programmes relevant to this agreement and of the other party.

9 Confidentiality

- 9.1 Each party undertakes that it shall not at any time disclose to any person any confidential information concerning the business, affairs, students or suppliers of the other party, except as permitted by clause 9.2.
- 9.2 Each party may disclose the other party's confidential information :
- (a) to its employees, officers, representatives or advisers who need to know such information for the purposes of exercising the party's rights or carrying out its obligations in connection with this agreement. Each party shall ensure that its employees, officers, representatives or advisers to whom it discloses the other party's confidential information comply with this clause 9; and
 - (b) as may be required by law, a court of competent jurisdiction or any governmental or regulatory authority (including the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 or the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004).
- 9.3 No party shall use any other party's confidential information for any purpose other than to exercise its rights and perform its obligations under or in connection with this agreement.

10 Data Protection

- 10.1 In relation to any personal data shared in relation to this agreement, the parties shall be considered data controllers in common and shall not be joint controllers.
- 10.2 Each party shall ensure that it complies with its obligations under Data Protection Laws. NUK acknowledges that certain Data Protection Laws (such as the Regulation (EU) 2016/679) may apply to NUK regardless of the location of NUK.
- 10.3 Prior to sharing personal data, each party shall ensure it is allowed to do so under applicable laws. NUK shall ensure that its students and potential students understand that NUK will share their personal data with UoD as outlined in this agreement.
- 10.4 Each party shall take appropriate technical and organisational security measures against unauthorised or unlawful processing of personal data, or the loss, destruction, alteration, damage or access to any data.

10.5 At the request of UoD, NUK shall enter into a separate data sharing agreement with UoD on the terms determined by UoD acting reasonably in accordance with the Data Protection Laws.

11 Anti-Corruption

11.1 Each party shall;

- (a) comply with all applicable laws, statutes, regulations, and codes relating to anti-bribery and anti-corruption including, but not limited to, the United Kingdom's Bribery Act 2010 ("Relevant Requirements");
- (b) not engage in any activity, practice or conduct which would constitute an offence under sections 1, 2 or 6 of the Bribery Act 2010 if such activity, practice or conduct had been carried out in the UK;
- (c) have and shall maintain in place throughout the term of this agreement its own policies and procedures, including (but not limited to) adequate procedures under the Bribery Act 2010, to ensure compliance with the Relevant Requirements, and will enforce them where appropriate; and
- (d) promptly report to the other party any request or demand for any undue financial or other advantage of any kind received by it in connection with the performance of this agreement.

11.2 NUK undertakes to comply with UoD's Ethics, Anti-bribery and Anti-corruption Policies (in each case as available on UoD's website or intranet) as updated from time to time.

11.3 Breach of this clause 11 shall be deemed a material breach of this agreement.

11.4 For the purpose of this clause 11, the meaning of "adequate procedures" shall be determined in accordance with the Bribery Act 2010 (and any guidance issued under that legislation).

12 Term of this Agreement

12.1 This agreement will come into effect on the commencement date as indicated in the Articulation Details.

12.2 The agreement shall, unless terminated earlier in accordance with its terms, continue in effect in respect of student admission to the UoD in the academic years as detailed in the Articulation Details.

12.3 The effectiveness of the collaboration will be reviewed by both parties on the review date indicated in the Articulation Details. At any time within sixt (60) days of the review, the UoD shall have the option to terminate the Agreement by giving NUK prior written notice to that effect.

12.4 The agreement may be extended or renewed by mutual agreement following the review.

13 Termination

13.1 Either party may terminate this agreement by giving the other party prior the required length of written notice as set out in the Articulation Details.

13.2 Either party may terminate this agreement with immediate effect by giving written notice to the other party if such other party :

- (a) is unable to fulfil its obligations under this agreement legally within its territory;
- (b) commits a material breach of any term of this agreement which breach is irremediable or (if such breach is remediable) fails to remedy that breach within a period of 60 days after being notified in writing to do so;
- (c) repeatedly breaches any of the terms of this agreement in such a manner as to reasonably justify the opinion that its conduct is inconsistent with it having the intention or ability to give effect to the terms of this agreement; or
- (d) suspends, or threatens to suspend, payment of its debts or is unable to pay its debts as they fall due or has a liquidator, receiver, administrator or similar authority appointed over all or any part of its business or assets, or suspends or ceases to carry on its business, or if an event equivalent to any such event occurs with respect to the other party in any jurisdiction to which it is subject.

13.3 The UoD may terminate this agreement with immediate effect by giving written notice to the other where it determines on the advice of counsel that :

- (a) it is unable to fulfil its obligations under this agreement legally within its territory; and
- (b) this collaboration would materially jeopardise its accreditation.

13.4 Following termination :

- (a) NUK shall immediately cease marketing the articulation possibilities to the UoD Programme to its students and potential students;
- (b) the termination of this agreement shall be undertaken in a manner that takes account of the concerns and circumstances of students who are students at the UoD as a result of articulation;
- (c) UoD shall exercise reasonable endeavours to honour all formal offers for admission that it has made to students of NUK in respect of the UoD Programme;
- (d) UoD may consider applications of any students who have commenced their studies at NUK; and
- (e) the following clauses shall remain in force : clause 1.2 (Nature of the Agreement), clauses 4.3(c) and 4.3(d) (NUK Obligations), clauses 8.1 and 8.6 (Intellectual Property and Marketing Materials), clause 9 (Confidentiality), this clause 13 (Termination), clause 14 (Disputes and Mediation), clause 15 (Limitation of Liability), clause 16 (Notices), clause 17 (Language), clause 18 (General) and the Schedule.

13.5 Termination shall not affect any claims or rights which a party may have against the other which have accrued prior to termination.

14 Disputes and Mediation

- 14.1 Should any dispute arise relating to this collaboration, the Link Co-ordinators shall seek to resolve such dispute collaboratively by negotiating in good faith. Either party may give the other notice of a dispute setting out the nature of such dispute. Should the Link Co-ordinators fail to achieve resolution within 30 days from the date of such notice, the issue will be referred to mediation.
- 14.2 The parties agree to enter into mediation in good faith to settle disputes and will do so in accordance with the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution (“CEDR”) Model Mediation Procedure. Either party may serve the other notice to commence mediation. Unless otherwise agreed between the parties within 14 days of notice of the mediation, the mediator will be nominated by CEDR.
- 14.3 If no agreement can be reached in mediation, the dispute will be taken before a competent court in accordance with clause 18.11 (General).
- 14.4 The location of the mediation shall be Dundee, UK, and the language shall be English.

15 Limitation of Liability

- 15.1 Nothing in this agreement will :
- (a) limit or exclude any liability for death or personal injury resulting from negligence; or
 - (b) limit or exclude any liability for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or
 - (c) limit any liabilities in any way that is not permitted under applicable law; or
 - (d) exclude any liabilities that may not be excluded under applicable law.
- 15.2 Neither party shall be liable for (a) any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense of any nature that is of an indirect, special or consequential nature; or (b) any loss of profits, revenue, reputation or goodwill (whether direct or indirect).
- 15.3 Subject to clauses 15.1 and 15.2, UoD’s total liability under or in relation to this agreement, including for any breach of the terms of this agreement or otherwise shall not exceed the total amount received by UoD from students as a result of this agreement.

16 Notices

- 16.1 Any notice required to be given under this agreement will be served personally, by first class post or (international) courier to the address of the relevant party’s Link Co-ordinator. Any notice so given will be deemed to have been duly served if :
- (a) personally delivered, on the day of delivery; or
 - (b) if sent by post or courier within the United Kingdom, forty-eight (48) hours after posting; or
 - (c) if sent by international courier, 7 days after posting.
- 16.2 Any notice given under or in connection with this agreement shall be in the English language.

17 Language

- 17.1 This agreement is drafted in the English language. If this agreement is translated into any other language, the English language version shall prevail.
- 17.2 All other documents provided under or in connection with this agreement shall be in the English language, or accompanied by a certified English translation. If such document is translated into any other language, the English language version shall prevail.

18 General

- 18.1 The definitions in the Schedule shall apply to this agreement.
- 18.2 Neither party shall be in breach of this agreement nor liable for delay in performing, or failure to perform, any of its obligations if such delay or failure result from events, circumstances or causes beyond its reasonable control. In such circumstances the affected party shall be entitled to a reasonable extension of the time for performing such obligations. If the period of delay or non-performance continues for 60 days, the party not affected may terminate this agreement by giving 30 days' written notice to the affected party.
- 18.3 No party shall be entitled to assign, novate, transfer, sub-license or sub-contract any of its rights or obligations under this agreement without the prior written consent of the other party.
- 18.4 This agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties in relation to its subject matter and supersedes any prior arrangements, understandings, promises or agreements made or existing between the parties regarding its subject matter.
- 18.5 No amendment of any term of this agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by or on behalf of each party.
- 18.6 No failure or delay by a party to exercise any right or remedy provided under this agreement or by law shall constitute a waiver of that or any other right or remedy, nor shall it prevent or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right or remedy. No single or partial exercise of such right or remedy shall prevent or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right or remedy.
- 18.7 Nothing in this agreement shall be construed as establishing or implying any partnership or joint venture between the parties and nothing in this agreement shall be deemed to constitute one party as an agent of another party or authorise a party to bind another party.
- 18.8 Nothing in this agreement creates legal rights for the benefit of third parties.
- 18.9 If any provision or part-provision of this agreement is or becomes invalid, illegal or unenforceable, it shall be deemed modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it valid, legal and enforceable. If such modification is not possible, the relevant provision or part-provision shall be deemed deleted. Any modification to or deletion of a provision or part-provision under this clause shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the rest of this agreement.

- 18.10 This agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered shall constitute a duplicate original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute the one agreement.
- 18.11 This agreement shall be interpreted and applied in accordance with the laws of Scotland and, other than where the parties endeavour to resolve disputes in accordance with the mediation procedures at clause 14 (Disputes and Mediation), the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts.

4 銜接形式與學位授予

- (a) 遵守良好學術實務與相關業界慣例 (含不歧視原則)；
- (b) 對其課程之標準與品質，以及提供學生之服務與設施負責；
- (c) 對可能影響課程執行、標準、品質、學習資源或招生之事項，事先書面通知對方；
- (d) 遵守所有適用法律與法規；
- (e) 遵循所有適用之品質保證與認證實務守則；
- (f) 取得並維持履行本合約所需之所有同意、許可、授權與基礎設施；
- (g) 依其權限與章程行事；
- (h) 妥善保存履行本合約義務之相關紀錄；
- (i) 提供對方合理所需資訊，以促進銜接安排之有效運作與發展 (含成績單所需資料)。

22 溝通與協調

22.1 雙方各指定一名聯絡協調人，負責：

- (a) 作為銜接安排之主要聯絡窗口；
- (b) 處理與管理所有相關事宜；
- (c) 迅速回應對方協調人之聯繫。

22.2 雙方得更換聯絡協調人，並應事先通知對方聯絡協調人。

23 財務安排

- 23.1 學生應支付UoD課程之學費與其他財務安排，詳情載於「銜接細節」。UoD每年自行決定學費金額。
- 23.2 若某學年學生未通過該學年UoD課程，且得以重修者，則須依該重修學年費率支付重修相關學費。
- 23.3 雙方不得代表對方產生、承諾或授權任何財務支出。
- 23.4 雙方各自負責其課程執行及本合約協商與履行所產生之費用。
- 23.5 學生應自付其住宿、教材與設備、交通、保險、醫療費用、護照與移民許可等相關成本及費用。

24 智慧財產權與行銷資料

- 24.1 除本合約另有明文規定，雙方不得主張對方之智慧財產權（含既有權利、因本合約產生之權利、名稱與品牌權利）。雙方同意不註冊、爭議或挑戰對方之智慧財產權。
- 24.2 雙方授予對方一項非專屬、免權利金之授權，於本合約期間使用對方名稱、商標、品牌與課程資訊於核准之宣傳資料中。授權於合約終止或屆滿時終止。
- 24.3 一方提供予另一方之資料或資訊，應以免權利金且「現況提供」方式供使用，僅限於履行本合約義務，且不得轉授或再授權予第三方。
- 24.4 除第8.5條外，任何提及銜接安排、對方或包含對方品牌之宣傳與行銷資料，須事先提交予對方書面核准（可透過電子郵件）。若資料非英文，須附授權翻譯。
- 24.5 雙方應確保所有行銷資料準確，且不得包含貶低或誤導性陳述、錯誤或可能損害對方聲譽之內容。在清楚地描述合作的性質和程度，並且不對標準、品質、財務安排或服務做出誤導性評論之前提下，雙方可提及本銜接安排。
- 24.6 在本協議終止或到期時，任一方應立即停止使用對方的名稱、資料、標誌、商標、手冊及其他智慧財產權。
- 24.7 各方同意維護與本協議相關之學術課程及對方的聲譽與良好名聲。

25 保密條款

- 25.1 各方皆承諾，除第9.2條允許的情形外，於任何時間均不得向任何人揭露有關對方的業務、事務、學生或另一方支持者的任何機密資訊。
- 25.2 各方可在下列情況下揭露對方的機密資訊：
- (a) 向其教職員工、主管、代表或顧問揭露該等資訊，前提是該等人員因行使本協議下該方的權利或履行其義務而需知悉該等資訊。各方應確保其教職員工、主管、代表或顧問遵守本第9條之規定；
 - (b) 根據法律、有管轄權之法院命令或任何政府或監管機關（包括《2002年蘇格蘭資訊自由法》或《2004年蘇格蘭環境資訊條例》）的要求所必須揭露者。
- 25.3 任何一方不得將其他方的機密資訊用於履行本協議或與本協議相關事項以外的任何目的。

26 資料保護

- 26.1 於因本協議而共享的任何個人資料，雙方應被視為「共同資料控制者」，而非「聯合資料控制者」。
- 26.2 各方應確保遵守資料保護法律所規定的義務。NUK 承認，某些資料保護法律（例如《歐盟一般資料保護規則 (Regulation (EU) 2016/679)》）得適用於 NUK，即使 NUK 並不位於該法律適用地區內。
- 26.3 在共享個人資料之前，各方應確保其依據適用法律有權進行該等共享。NUK 應確保其學生與潛在學生了解 NUK 將依據本協議之規定與 UoD 共享其個人資料。

26.4 各方應採取適當的技術性與組織性安全措施，以防止未經授權或非法處理個人資料，或資料的遺失、毀損、變更、損害或被存取。

26.5 應 UoD 之要求下，NUK 應與 UoD 簽署一份由 UoD 合理依據資料保護法律所制定條款的獨立資料共享協議。

27 反貪腐

27.1 各方應：

- (a) 遵守所有適用的反賄賂與反貪腐相關法律、法規、規章與守則，包括但不限於《2010年英國反賄賂法》(下稱「相關規定」)；
- (b) 不得從事任何在英國境內若為實施即構成《2010年英國反賄賂法》第1、2或6條所規範之犯罪行為的活動、行為或實務；
- (c) 在本協議有效期間內，應訂立並維持自身的政策與程序(包括但不限於符合《2010年反賄賂法》之適當程序)，以確保符合相關規定，並於適當時加以執行；
- (d) 應立即向對方通報其在履行本協議過程中所收到的任何不當金錢利益或其他形式利益之請求或要求。

27.2 NUK 承諾遵守 UoD 的《倫理政策》、《反賄賂政策》與《反貪腐政策》(各政策版本可於 UoD 官網或內部網站查閱，並可能不時更新)。

27.3 違反本第11條之行為，將視為對本協議的重大違約行為。

27.4 就本第11條而言，「適當程序」的定義應依據《2010年英國反賄賂法》(及其下所發布的任何指引)予以確定。

28 協議期間

28.1 本協議自「銜接細節」中所載之起始日起生效。

28.2 除非依據本協議條款提前終止，本協議將在「銜接細節」中所載之學術年度內持續有效，以供學生申請入學至 UoD。

28.3 雙方將於「銜接細節」中所載之檢討日期對合作成效進行檢討。在檢討後六十(60)日內的任何時間，UoD 得選擇以書面通知 NUK 終止本協議。

28.4 本協議可經雙方同意，於檢討後延長或續約。

29 終止

29.1 任一方可依據「銜接細節」中所載之通知期限，提前以書面通知對方終止本協議。

29.2 如符合下列任一情形，任一方可立即以書面通知對方終止本協議：

- (a) 對方於其轄區內無法合法履行本協議項下之責任；
- (b) 對方嚴重違反本協議任何條款，且該違約行為無法補救，或(如可補救)在收到書面通知後60日內未予以補救者；
- (c) 對方多次違反本協議之條款，致使合理認為其行為與履行本協議之意圖或能力不符；
- (d) 對方暫停或威脅暫停債務支付、無法償付到期債務，或其全部或部分業務或資產已由清算人、接管人、管理人或類似機構接管，或已暫停或停止業務，或於其所屬之任何司法管轄區發生相同效力之事件者。

29.3 若 UoD 經法律顧問建議認定下列情況存在時，得立即以書面通知終止本協議：

- (a) 在其轄區內無法合法履行本協議之責任；且
- (b) 此項合作將嚴重危及 UoD 之學術認證資格。

29.4 終止後：

- (a) NUK 應立即停止向其學生及潛在學生宣傳與 UoD 課程銜接相關之機會；
- (b) 本協議之終止應考量經由課程銜接就讀 UoD 的學生之權益與情況，以妥善方式執行；
- (c) UoD 應盡合理努力，履行其已對 NUK 學生提出之正式入學錄取；
- (d) 得考慮已在 NUK 開始就學中之學生之入學申請；且
- (e) 以下條款於終止後仍繼續有效：第1.2條（協議性質）、第4.3(c)與4.3(d)條（NUK 義務）、第8.1與8.6條（智慧財產權與行銷資料）、第9條（保密條款）、本第13條（終止）、第14條（爭議與調解）、第15條（責任限制）、第16條（通知）、第17條（語言）、第18條（一般條款）以及附件。

29.5 協議之終止不影響任一方在終止前已產生之任何請求權或權利。

30 爭議與調解

- 30.1 若本合作關係產生任何爭議，由雙方之聯絡協調人本於誠信協商原則共同尋求解決。任一方可向對方發出書面通知，說明爭議的性質。如聯絡協調人於通知發出後30日內未能解決爭議，該爭議即提交調解處理。
- 30.2 雙方同意本於誠信原則進行調解以解決爭議，並依據英國「高效爭議解決中心」(CEDR)所制定的《標準調解程序》進行。任一方可向對方發出通知以啟動調解程序。除非雙方於通知調解後14日內另有協議，則調解人將由 CEDR 指派。
- 30.3 若調解未能達成協議，爭議將依據第18.11條（一般條款）提交具管轄權之法院解決。
- 30.4 調解地點為英國丹地 (Dundee, UK)，調解語言為英語。

31 責任限制

- 31.1 本協議之任何條款均不得：
 - (a) 限制或排除因過失造成的死亡或人身傷害的法律責任；
 - (b) 限制或排除詐欺或欺詐性失實陳述的法律責任；
 - (c) 以任何適用法律不允許的方式限制任何責任；或
 - (d) 排除適用法律所不允許排除的任何責任。
- 31.2 任一方均不對下列損害負責：(a) 任何間接、特殊或衍生性質的損失、責任、損害、費用或支出；或(b) 利潤、營收、聲譽或信譽的損失（無論為直接或間接損失）。
- 31.3 在不違反第15.1與15.2條規定之前提下，UoD 就本協議或與本協議有關之事宜所承擔的全部責任（包括任何違約責任）不得超過 UoD 因本協議而從學生收取之總金額。

32 通知

- 32.1 根據本協議須發出之任何通知，應以親送、英國一級郵件或（國際）快遞方式送達至相關方之聯絡協調人地址。此類通知視以下情況視為已妥善送達：
 - (a) 若為親自遞送，則以遞送當日為準；或
 - (b) 若於英國境內以郵件或快遞寄送，則於寄出後48小時；或

(c) 若為國際快遞寄送，則於寄出後7日。

32.2 根據本協議所發出或與本協議有關之任何通知，皆應以英文撰寫。

33 語言

33.1 本協議以英文撰寫。如本協議翻譯為其他語言版本，以英文版本為準。

33.2 根據或與本協議有關所提供之其他文件，應以英文撰寫，或附有經認證之英文翻譯。如有翻譯版本，均以英文版本為準。

34 一般條款

34.1 附表中的定義之術語適用於本協議。

34.2 任一方對本協議之違約或延遲履行，若係因無法合理控制之事件、情況或原因所致，則不視為違約。受影響方有權獲得合理的履行期間延長。如延遲或未履行持續達60日，未受影響方得以30天書面通知終止本協議。

34.3 未經對方事先書面同意，任一方均無權轉讓、讓與、移轉、再授權或分包其於本協議下之任何權利或義務。

34.4 本協議構成雙方對其標的事項之完整協議，並取代雙方先前就該等事項所作之任何安排、了解、承諾或協議。

34.5 本協議之任何條款修改，均須以書面形式經雙方簽署始生效力。

34.6 任何一方未行使或延遲行使本協議或法律賦予之任何權利或救濟，均不得視為對該權利或救濟之放棄。任何權利或救濟之部分或單一行使，亦不妨礙其進一步或其他行使。

34.7 本協議不應被解釋為在雙方之間建立或暗示任何合夥或合資關係，亦不構成任何一方為另一方之代理人，或授權其代表另一方行事。

34.8 本協議不為第三方創設任何法律權利。

34.9 若本協議任何條款或部分條款被視為無效、違法或不可執行，則應視為已經最小程度修改，以使其有效、合法且可執行。若無法修改，則該條款或部分條款視為刪除。該條款之修改或刪除不影響本協議其餘部分之效力。

34.10 本協議得以任意數量之副本簽署，各副本於簽署並交付後視為具有同等法律效力之正本，但所有副本合併視為同一協議。

34.11 本協議應依據蘇格蘭法律解釋與適用。除雙方依第14條（爭議與調解）先行協商外，雙方同意專屬提交予蘇格蘭法院管轄。
